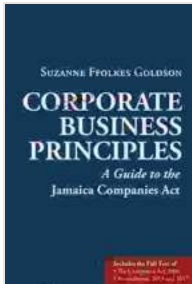

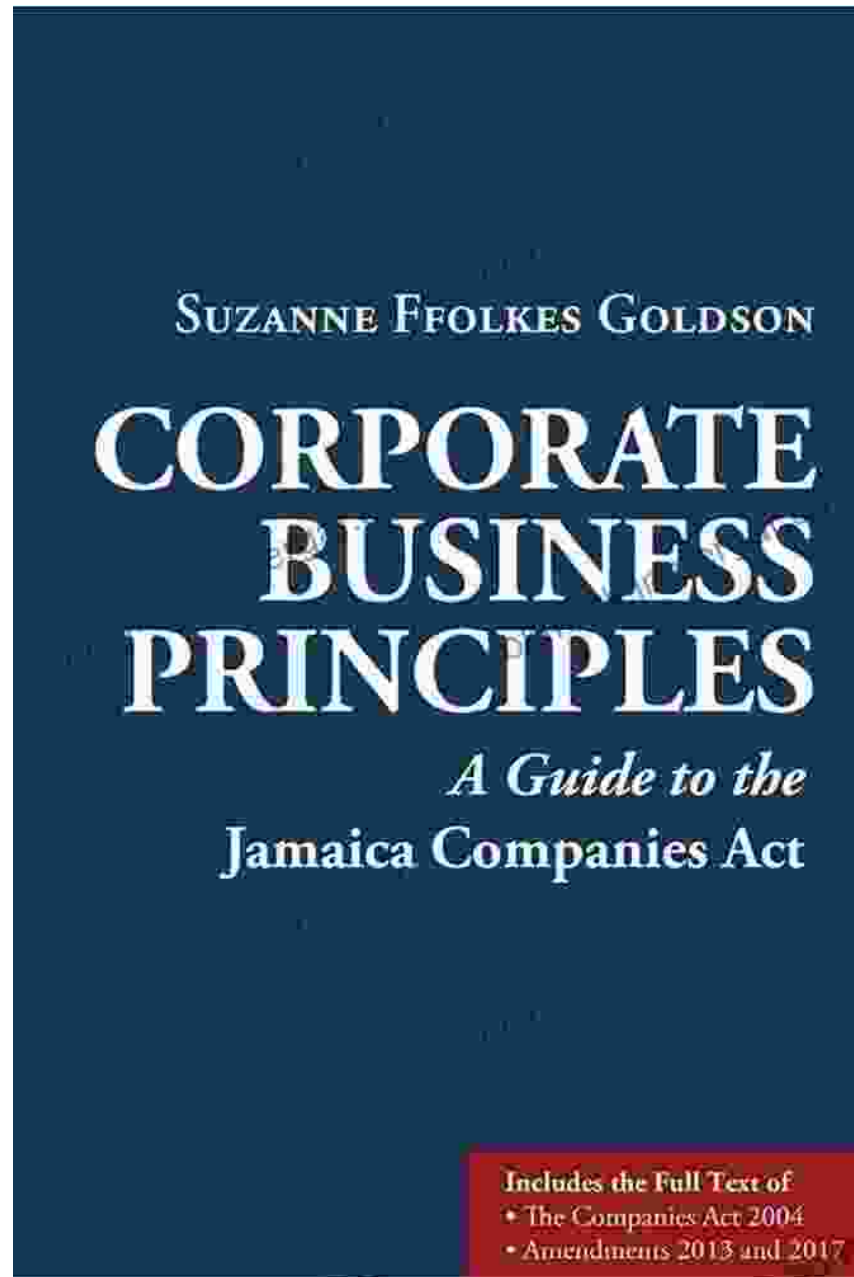

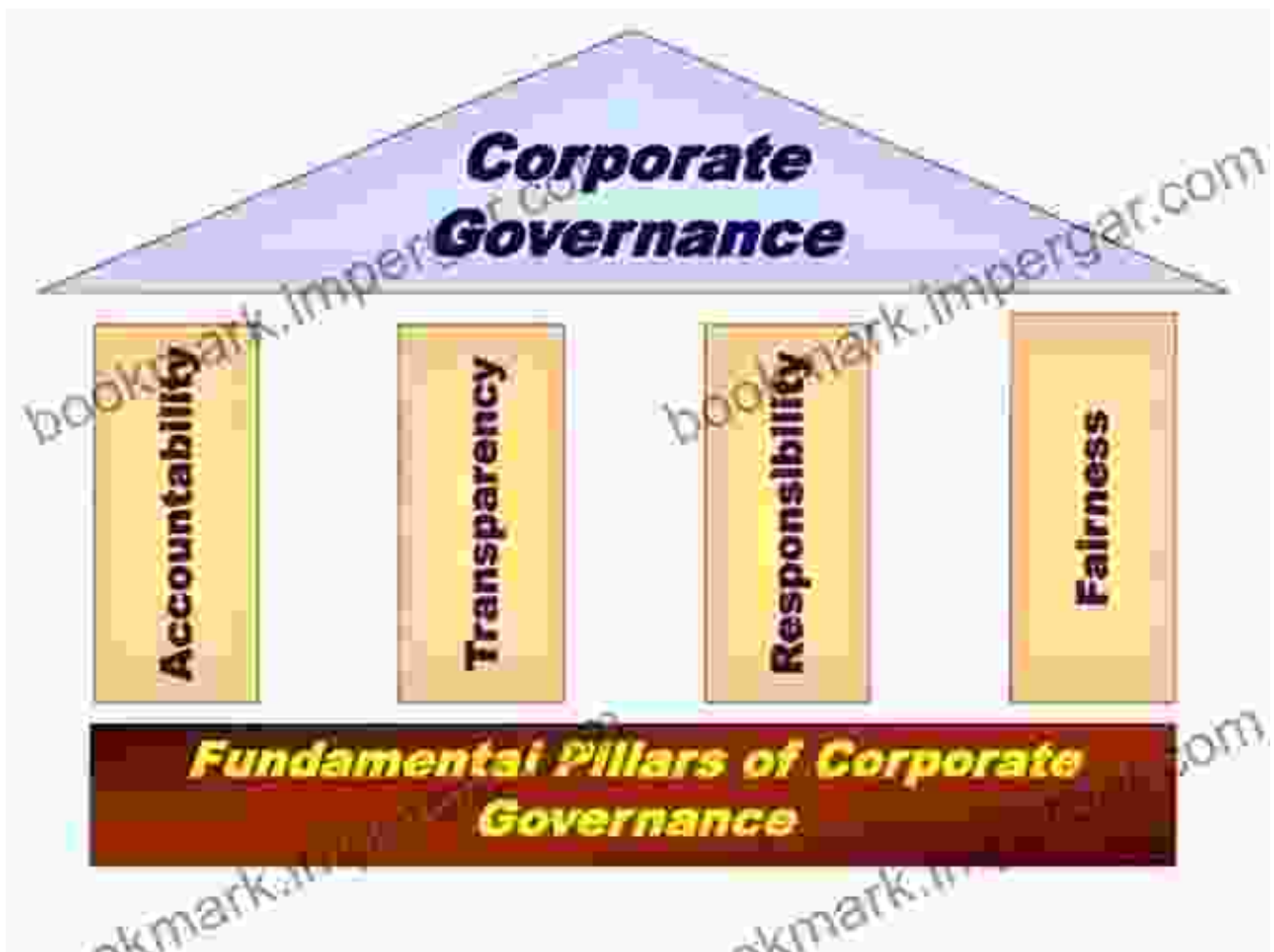

Shelby County v. Holder	2013	Held that a state cannot have a voting law that is either as a condition or a result of race or color and that
Brown v. Board of Education	1954	Segregation in public schools is unconstitutional
Civil Rights Act	1964	Prohibits discrimination by public accommodations, public accommodations by employers
Swann v. Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools	1971	Established the legality of busing to public schools to achieve desegregation
Regents of the Univ. of California	1978	Held that a state can have an affirmative action plan that is one of the most effective ways to achieve diversity in higher education

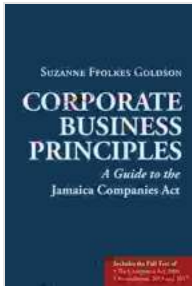

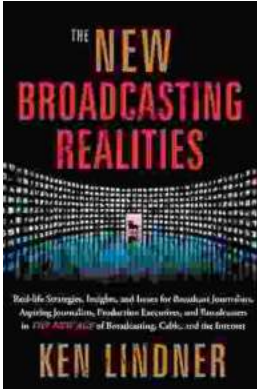
